Every candle has a custom blended wax formulation to ensure the optimum melting point and ability to hold fragrance oil. These special wax formulations help maintain an even, clean burn.

Stages of Fragrance Evaporation

Their fragrance oils are complex combinations of top, middle and base notes that are developed to bring the very best fragrance.

Top Notes: The first scent impressions; the most volatile ingredients. They evaporate quickly, leading to the middle notes.

Middle Notes: Evolving scents which develop over a bit more time; the heart of the fragrance.

Base Notes: Underlying notes, which gradually come through, the strongest and longest lasting.
